Matches the needs of the Meeting and its committees with the gifts and leadings of individual Friends and Attenders.

Care and Counsel Committee (reserved for FMA members)

Provides pastoral care for the members of the faith community.

Peace and Social Concerns

Oversees how our Meeting expresses Quaker testimonies in the wider world by supporting and seasoning leadings of individual Friends, the Austin monthly meeting and the wider Austin community in peace and social concerns work.

Worship and Ministry (reserved for FMA members)

Fosters and strengthens the spiritual life of the Meeting by nurturing the Meeting for Worship and the spiritual growth of individuals in the meeting.
